 States of Georgia of the one part, and Sabun Morris of the County Craven, and State of North
 Carolina of the other part. Witnesseth, That was the said Levi Gattin Major Gattin,
 Benjamin Pearce, and belie his wife, William Took, and Polly his wife, Stephen

Gattin, Turniford Gattin, Hardy Gattin, and James Roach and his Wife Betsey. — for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to us in hand paid by the said Saban Morris before the sealing and delivering of these presents, Haths, bargained, granted, sold aliened enfeoffed, confirmed, and by these presents do bargain, grant, sell, alien, enfeoff, convey & confirm, unto the said Saban Morris a certain piece or parcel of land, situate lying, and being in the County of Craven aforesaid, on the North side of Nuse River, and North side of Malls Swamp, Beginning at a Pine near the head of water branch in or near Bryans line, running S. 80 E. 101 Poles to a white wood stump near a meadow, then North 20 Poles to a Pine in or near John Nelsons line, then N. 77 W. 206 poles to a Stake near a small draw, and near Elingers Nelsons corner two Pines then with a straight line to the beginning. bearing date 24th January 1783.
