dred and Ten dollars in hand paid by the said
Lewis Morris before the sealing and delivery of these
presents and the said Jeremiah Heath have bar-
gained sold conveyed and set over to the said Lewis
Morris a certain tract or parcel of land lying &
being in the County aforesaid and on the east side
of the great branch and bore creek. Beginning
at a pine on the run of said branch and runs South
seventy five East two hundred and twelve pole to center
of three pines in said Heath's back line then North
thirteen West seventy two pole with his line to a pine
his corner on the side of a large path then North
seventy five west One hundred and thirty one pole
to a white Oak, another of said Heath's corners then
South Eighty four west thirty two pole to the run
of great branch at the bridge then with the run of
said branch to the Beginning containing sixty
two acres, To have and to hold all the said bar-
gained premises unto the said Lewis Morris his
heirs and assigns forever, free and clear from all incum-

 Witnesseth that I the aforesaid Moses Chance for
 and in consideration of the sum of three hundred
 pound lawful money of the state aforesaid to me
 in hand paid before the sealing and delivery of
 these presents, the receipt whereof I do hereby ac-
 knowledged and myself to be therewith fully satis-
 fied contented and paid: have given granted
 bargained and sold and by these presents doth
 give grant bargain and sell convey and confirm
 assy and set over unto the aforesaid Frederick
 Lane a certain piece or parcel of land Situate
 lying and being in the County of Brazen and State
 aforesaid lying between Neuse River and Swifts
 Creek joining broad branch call'd the Land hills
 Beginning at a pine on broad branch and runs
 west 320 poles to a pine then South 320 poles to a
 pine then East 320 poles to a red oak then North
 320 poles to the first station containing six hundred
 and forty acres, by virtue of a patent granted to
