Craven County Murphy for the natural love & affection I do bear for
my son Guilford Murphy and also for & in consideration of the sum of five
shillings to me in hand paid do give grant set over to my said son Guilford
Murphy two shares beasts, named Doll and Sophia also all my stock of all
hogs & sheep of the mark of Cross & hole the left ear & Cross & slit the right
ear, also three feather beds and all the furniture together with all the house
hold & kitchen furniture & three hand mills and all the mason, corn &
fodder, also all my homespun cloath spun stuff, Cotton & flax to have & to
hold the said shares, Cattle, Hogs & Sheep & against the lawfull claim or claims
of all person whatever unto him the said Guilford Murphy his heirs, Cars
and assigns forever. In witness whereof I the said Lucey Murphy hath
set my hand & seal the fifteenth day of March 1799.

& Ninety Nine of our Lord. Aron Morris, Craven County & State of North
Carolina Planter of the one part & William Brooks of the County & State
aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that the aforesaid Aron Morris
for and in consideration of the sum of fifty Pounds current money of
the State aforesaid to him the aforesaid Aron Morris in hand paid by
the aforesaid William Brooks before the enclosing & delivery of these
presents, the receipt whereof the aforesaid Aron Morris doth acknowledge
and himself therewith satisfied contented & paid have by these presents, bar-
gained, sold, made over unto the said William Brooks a certain tract or por-
tionment of land, situate lying & being in Craven County & State aforesaid
it being thirty acres of land, beginning at a white Oak in the Swamp
on the line that parts Benjamin Whitakers and J. Carruthers land and
runs along said line N. 26 W. 65 pole to a Holly a corner of said Carruthers
patent, then along the line of the patent N. 80 pole to a Gum then run-
ning a direct course to the back line to conclude thirty acres of land
to have & to hold to him the aforesaid William Brooks to him his heirs
Execu^{rs} Adm^{rs} and assigns forever the aforesaid Lands & premises
with all improvements thereunto belonging, And the aforesaid Aron Morris
do by these presents bind myself to and with the aforesaid Wm Brooks
to and with him his heirs & assigns warrant and forever defend the aforesaid
land and premises against me my heirs, Exec^{rs} Adm^{rs} and assigns the
aforesaid Aron Morris forever or any person or persons claims thereto
in witness whereof the s. Aron Morris have hereunto set my hand & seal
the day & year first above mentioned.
