

This Indenture made the Twenty first day of November eighteen hundred and fifteen — by and between Tho K Torrano of the County of Sampson & State of North Carolina of the one part & Gideon Heath of the County of Craven & State aforesaid of the other part. — Witnesseth that the said Tho K Torrano for & in consideration of ^{the sum of} one hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Gideon Heath the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted bargained sold alienated & confirmed by these presents unto the said Gideon Heath his heirs & assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in the County of Craven & State aforesaid Beginning at a pine on the East side of the Juniper Swamp & runs thence N^o. 34 W^t. 20 poles to a pine James Newports corner then with his line N 55 W. 60 poles to a laurel thence South S^o. 44 W. 151 poles to a pine in Thomas Whitherington line thence along his other line S^o. 33 W. 294 poles to his other corner then S^o. 55 E 90 poles to a stake then a direct line to the first station Excepting fifty acres of land included in S^o. boundaries which the sd Tho K Torrano have heretofore conveyed to William Watson which leaves a balance of two hundred acres more or less together with the whole dittaments & appertances thereto belonging To have & to hold the said tract or parcels of land with all & singular the dittaments & appertances thereto belonging unto the said Gideon Heath his heirs & assigns for ever, & the said Tho K Torrano for himself his heirs & assigns doth for ever warrant & defend the above bargained premises, against the lawful claim of all manner of persons whatever holding or claiming by from or under him them or any of them unto him the said Gideon Heath his heirs & assigns for ever In witness whereof the party hath hereunto put his hand & seal the day & year first above written — — — — —



This Indenture made this Sixteenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen, Between Sabau Morris of the State of North Carolina, and County of Craven of the one part, and Hiram Pollard of the same State, and County aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Sabau Morris, for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said by the said Hiram Pollard, hath bargained, sold alienated, enfeoffed, conveyed —

and confirmed, and by these presents, do bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff, convey, and confirm unto the said Hiram Pollard incertain pieces, or parcels of land, situate lying and being in the County of Craven aforesaid, on the North side of Neuse River, and North side of Halls Swamp, Beginning at a Pine near the head of Watery branch, in or near Brigans line, running S. 80 E. 101 Poles to a light wood, Plum, near a Meadow, then N. 77 W. 206 poles to a Pine, in or near John Nelsons line, then N. 77 W. 206 poles to a stake near a small drain, and near Elizager Nelsons corner two Pines, then with a straight line to the beginning, containing two hundred acres, patent bearing date 24th January 1783. Reference being had thereto will more fully appear of Record, which said piece or parcel of land, the said Laban Morris purchased of the Heirs of Hardy Gatlin Esquire deceased, in the year one thousand eight hundred and fourteen, as by deed will appear, bearing date 17th May. To have and to hold to him the said Hiram Pollard his heirs and assigns for ever the above bargained land and premises. Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging, or in any wise appertaining to him the said Hiram Pollard his heirs and assigns. And I the said Laban Morris for myself, and each of my heirs, doth covenant to and with the said Hiram Pollard, his heirs and assigns to defend unto the said Hiram Pollard the above described tract or parcel of land, against the lawful claim of each of my heirs, and from the further claims of any person, claiming by, from or under me.
