Witnesseth that I Richard Richardson ^{Junr} for and in consider-
ation Two hundred dollars to me in hand paid before the sealing
and delivering of these presents by Ephraim Daughtry the receipts
whereof is hereby acknowledged have given granted bargained &
sold and by these presents do give grant bargain & sell unto the
said Ephraim Daughtry ^{Junr} a certain tract or parcel of land
lying & being in the County aforesaid on the south side of Newse
river containing one hundred & fifty acres or more adjoining the
lands of Mr Sarah Berry & James Beasley and the lands of
Thomas White & Stephen White being part of a patent gran-
ted John Gooding bearing date the first day January 1793.
To have & to hold said bargained premises to him the said Ephraim
Daughtry ^{Junr} to him his heirs executors administrators or assigns
forever. And I Richard Richardson ^{Junr} do covenant to and with
the said Ephraim Daughtry to warrant and forever defend the
aforesaid bargained premises to him the said Ephraim Daughtry
^{Junr} his heirs executors administrators or assigns forever against
the lawful claims or claims of any person or persons whatever.

 for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred & fifty dollars to him
 in hand paid by the said Harvey Morris at & before the sealing and
 delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 hath given bargained, sold, conveyed & confirmed & by these presents
 he the said Joseph Burney doth grant, bargain & sell convey & con-
 firm unto him the said Harvey Morris his heirs & assigns a certain
 tract or parcel of land situate lying & being on the north side of Nease
 river in the County & State aforesaid and on the south side of Bay river
 & on the upper side of Neale's Creek, Beginning at John Burney's corner
 on the river, with his line south six east, three hundred & twenty poles
 to the back line of the patent, then with line of patent Eighteen poles
 then north one & a half west to the river, then up the river to the
 beginning, containing by estimation fifty seven acres be the same
 more or less. To have and to hold the said tract of land with its
 appurtenances to the said Harvey Morris his heirs & assigns forever
 And the said Joseph Burney for himself his heirs executors and ad-
 ministrators to and with the said Harvey Morris his heirs & assigns
 doth hereby covenant & grant the said tract of land with its appurte-
 nances against himself the said Joseph Burney and his heirs and
 against the lawfull claims of all persons whatever, unto the said
 Harvey Morris and his heirs & assigns forever to warrant secure and
