This Indenture made the 27<sup>th</sup> June 1829 between William Jones on one part, and Nancy <sup>Morris</sup> & Penelope Herrington on the other part all of the State of North Carolina & County of Craven, Witnesseth that the said William Jones for and in consideration of the natural love and affection that he hath to the said Nancy Morris & Penelope Herrington and the better Maintenance of the same, have given granted enfeoffed and forever set over unto them the said Nancy & Penelope a certain tract of land containing 640 acres on Sandamore Creek, being a patent granted to Gideon Williams Beginning at a gum Francis Jones corner tree - then S<sup>o</sup> 60 degrees N<sup>o</sup> 320 poles to a Juniper, thence N<sup>o</sup> 30 deg. N<sup>o</sup> 320 poles to a gum, then N<sup>o</sup> 60 deg. East 320 poles to a Juniper, & then to the Beginning for 640 acres by estimation. To have and to hold the aforesaid land with all right-titles and privileges thereto, belonging free and clear from the lawful claim of any person whatever.
