I James McIntosh for and in consideration of the love and affection which I have for my son William McIntosh and my daughter Susan Morris wife of William Morris and for a further consideration of their finding & securing to me during my natural life a good & sufficient maintenance I do hereby give and grant unto my said children William McIntosh & Susan Morris aforesaid and their lawful heirs forever all my property which I own or am entitled to in any manner real & personal in the county of Craven reserving to myself the use of the plantation where I now live and any other article of personal property should I wish it during my life. Know all men by these presents that I Edward Nelson in consideration one dollar to me paid by Mrs. Nancy Thomson of Newbern for & divers other valuable considerations me thereunto moving have bargained & sold, remise, released and forever quit claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell, remise, release & forever quit claim to the said Nancy Thomson all my right title & interest to certain negroes conveyed to me Matthew Williams.

To have and to hold to the said Nancy Thomson her executors & administrators forever. and for myself and my heirs. I do covenant & agree to & with the said Nancy Thomson that I will warrant & defend the said negroes to the said Nancy Thomson against the lawful claims of all persons claiming by, from, through or under me.
