Coy for and in consideration of the sum of twenty six Dollars and fifty cents paid to me in hand by the said Morris before the sealing and delivering of these presents hath bargained sold and by these presents do bargain sell convey and confirm unto the said Morris him his heirs and assigns forever, one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the State and County aforesaid on the West side of Core Creek and on Wolf trap ridge and on both sides of Dover road beginning at a pine by the Barvis pond in Frederick Neath's line and runs with his line South twenty deg West twenty three poles to a stake in said line then North eighty five deg 85 West one hundred and sixty poles to a pine then North twenty deg East thirty poles to a pine then South eighty three deg East one hundred and sixty poles to the beginning containing twenty six and a half acres and said land was patented by Elisha Peasley grant bearing date 29th of November 1803. To have and to hold the above mentioned land unto him the said Morris him his heirs and assigns forever. And I the said M. W. 60 pole to the corner of the same then with another line of the same N. 15. W. 132 pole to a pine corner of the same then with another line of the same S. 25. E. 72 pole to the run of White oak branch then down and with the same to the given line of the said patent then along the same to the first station containing forty five acres and a half. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract of land with all and singular the benefits and emoluments and appurtenances hereunto belonging, and he the said Hardy Powell for himself heirs and assigns shall and will warrant and forever defend the above bargained premises against all claim or claims whatever unto him the said Penajah Baton. heirs and assigns forever.
